**This two-day seminar will explore Turkey's domestic and foreign policy by focusing on subjects such as nationalism, Kemalism, democratization, and Turkey's foreign policy in the post-Cold War era**

**Sinan Ciddi** gained his Ph.D. in Political Science from the School of Oriental and African Studies, University of London in June 2007. He was previously an instructor at Sabancı University between 2004-2008 and completed his Post-Doctoral Fellowship at the same institution between 2007-2008. He recently published a book titled *Kemalism in Turkish Politics: The Republican People's Party: Secularism and Nationalism* (Routledge, January 2009) focusing on the electoral weakness of the Republican People's Party. Between 2008-2011, he established the Turkish Studies program at the University of Florida's Center for European Studies.

**Lisel Hintz** is a Ph.D. candidate in Political Science at George Washington University and is a Visiting Research Fellow at Bilkent University in Ankara for the 2012-2013 academic year. Her research focuses on the role of identity in international relations along multiple levels of analysis. She is interested in the salience of particular identities (ethnic, religious, state/civic national, imperial) in particular contexts, as well as the strategic construction and adoption of national identities and the domestic push-back against such attempted constructions. Her dissertation project examines how domestic contestation over national identity informs and constrains the formulation of foreign policy in Turkey. She has written for publications such as *Foreign Policy*, *The Washington Journal of Turkish and Eurasian Affairs*, and *Hurriyet Daily News*.
